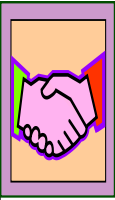
Mark and Jean will be away the next two Sundays. George McDonald will be preaching next week, and Kerry Eastridge the following Sunday.

SUNDAY SCHOOL CLASSES

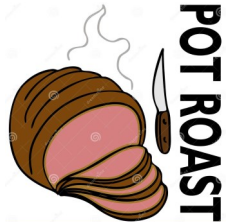
