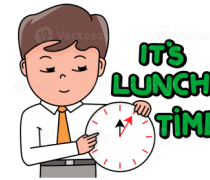

LADIES TEA SIGN UP LIST

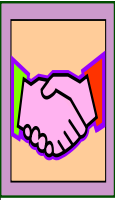
Calling all women! We are having a Ladies Tea on March 15th. Please see the list on the bulletin board to sign up and decorate one of the 10 tables.
